



PINE CENTRE MALL

Adult Supervision / Youth Policy

Effective January 1, 2012

Pine Centre strives to provide its customers with an exceptional shopping experience in a safe and secure environment. In order to ensure the safety and security of everyone at Pine Centre we have youth and adult supervision policies in place. The mall including the parking lot and its exterior businesses are private property. All visitors to the property are *bound to adhere to these policies*:

1. Children between the ages of 7 and 16 are not permitted in the mall during school hours, unless accompanied by a parent, teacher or legal guardian (excluding days when school is not in session i.e. ProD Days, Summer Vacation).
2. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted in the mall unless accompanied by a parent, teacher or legal guardian at any time. Children must remain within the company of their parent/guardian at all times.
3. Youth of all ages are required to abide by the centres Code of Conduct at all times while on the property.

In addition, one parent/guardian is permitted to supervise up to five teens (under the age of 17) unless they are a part of a 'school group' or 'sports team'; in this case, there should be at least one adult ON SITE that is responsible for the ENTIRE GROUP. It is NOT acceptable to drop off large groups of youth for pick up at a later time.

Acceptable proof of age is a driver's license, provincial picture ID, passport or current student card.

Failure to comply with the adult supervision or youth policies or any lawful or reasonable requests by Mall Management or Security may result in the loss of privilege to visit the mall and/or criminal prosecution if applicable. The mall will involve the RCMP and/or the Ministry of Children & Family Development when dealing with unaccompanied young children and/or unruly or unlawful behaviours by children (youth) of any age.
